## International Business Administration

The Europeanization and globalization of the economy shape the business practices of international corporations, but also the economic activities of mid-sized businesses. Viadrina's International Business Administration master program specifically emphasizes the international aspects of business administration and economics. Foreign language instruction and study abroad are integral components of our academic program. These facilitate the intermingling of students from different cultural backgrounds and promote the development of a common understanding of the complex connections within the global economy.

## Career prospects

Demand is ever increasing for specialists and executives specifically educated with regard to the worldwide interwovenness of economics and society. To help you meet professional and intercultural requirements, the International Business Administration master's program imparts – alongside economic know-how – core skills, such as intercultural skills, as well as know-how regarding various global business, law and taxation systems.

As part of this bilingual, two-year-long program, you will receive the preparation necessary to fulfill a demanding position either in multinational firms, international organizations, trade unions or in academia. If your grades are above average, then, after finishing your master's, you are entitled to pursue a doctoral degree, which also satisfies the requirements for an academic career. You may find support in both the Career Center and the Center for Entrepreneurship considering your chances to enter a career as well as on the subject of the foundation of your own business.

## Internationality

As part of double-master programs – and with select partner universities – you can simultaneously complete two degrees within the standard two-year study period. ## Admission requirements

Degree applicants need

- a bachelor's degree in the field of business administration and economics, i.e., this should have included a minimum of 30 ECTS credits in mathematics, statistics, information systems and micro- or macroeconomics
- English language certificate at the C1 level of the Common European Framework of References for Languages
- International students applying for the tracks FINE, FACT or M & M need proof of German language proficiency on a C1 level. Admitted tests are DSH (Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang), TestDaF or an equivalent test.
